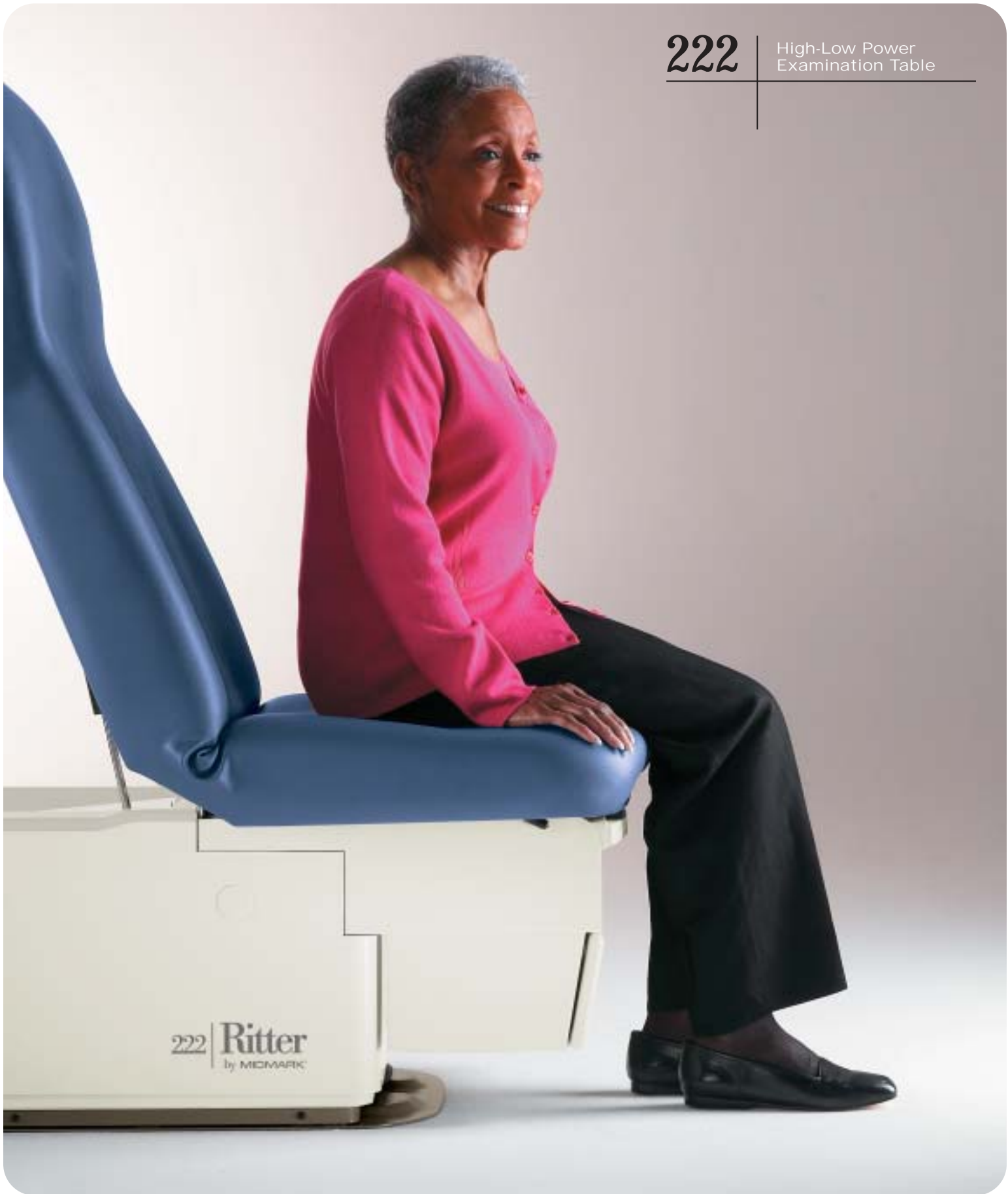

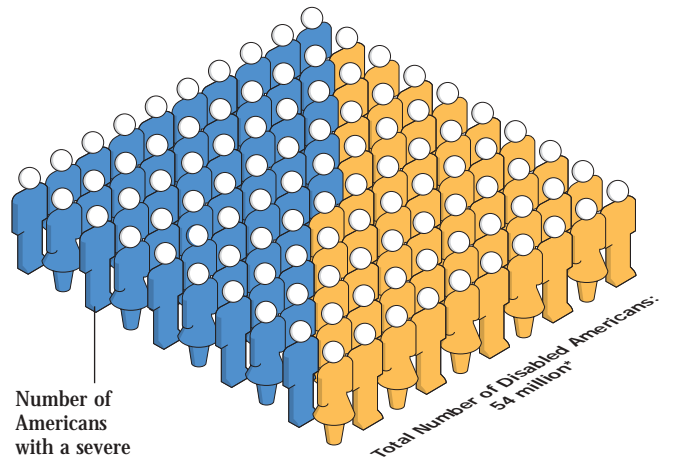
The Ritter 222 was designed with you, your patients and staff in mind. Its 18-inch low height helps the patient move onto and off the table faster, easier and safer.



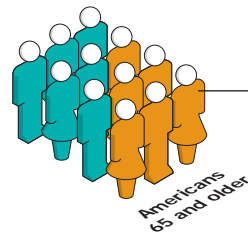
The 37-inch full height and optional pelvic tilt enables you to conduct an exam or a pap smear without stressing your back.
